What are the roles of a Harvest Students Leader?

The expectations for each life group leader in Harvest students can be best summarized by the acronym L.E.A.D.

Love

- For God Himself
- For God's Gospel
- For God's people
- For God's Mission

Example

- In your pursuit of righteousness
- In the way you live
- In Humility and teachability

Available

- To Wednesday nights
- To leader meetings once a month
- To volunteering long term
- To spending time with students

Devoted

- To reaching the lost
- To discipling students
- To being disciplined yourself

What is the time commitment?

- **Weekly:** Wednesday night gatherings from 6pm to 9pm.
- **Monthly:** Sunday Leader meetings during or after service.
- **Yearly:** Leaders commit on paper to at least 1 year of serving. My hope is that each leader would *personally* commit to 3 years of serving.
- **Events:** There will be some events that occur on other nights other than wednesday.
- **Attendance:** Leaders are allowed up to 3 misses from months September to May. ***This does not include unexpected sick days, emergencies etc.*

What are some basic week to week expectations?

- **Prayer Journals:** Leaders will be responsible for praying for their life groups weekly by responding in student prayer journals.
- **Reading Emails:** Leaders are responsible for reading the weekly emails sent to them by Pastor JT.
- **Life Groups:** It is imperative that every leader is also being disciplined in a life group or ministry outside of HSM.
- **Punctual:** Leaders are responsible for showing up on wednesday's at 6:00pm for prayer and a breifing on the night.
- **Reaching Parents and Students:** Leaders are responsible to be reaching out to parents (monthly) and students (weekly) in their life group by calling, texting, and or face to face meetings.
